Amor Europe: is planning to run training for pastors and children in Burkina Faso and Sierra Leone. In addition, they will be developing a partnership with the Evangelical Scout Movement of Burkina Faso – water filter distribution to Scouts and their families and training leaders in spiritual leadership. They also hope to build 7 houses for families this year. 5 in Mexico (2 in May with men, 2 in July with schools and 1 in August with a church from Middlesbrough) and 2 in Moldova (with young adults in August).

Burkina Faso: Please pray for the core team as they seek God's will regarding possible involvement in the building of a secondary school in Kodeni.
