Overseas work/workers connected to SKCC:

Amor Europe: is planning to run training for pastors and children in Burkina Faso and Sierra Leone. In addition, they will be developing a partnership with the Evangelical Scout Movement of Burkina Faso – water filter distribution to Scouts and their families and training leaders in spiritual leadership. They also hope to build 7 houses for families this year. 5 in Mexico (2 in May with men, 2 in July with schools and 1 in August with a church from Middlesborough) and 2 in Moldova (with young adults in August).

Burkina Faso: Please pray for the core team as they seek God’s will regarding possible involvement in the building of a secondary school in Kodeni.

Mozambique: Heather Pritchard & the boys at Kedesh Santuario.

Romania: Hospice Casa Sperantei and Irene & Aurora Christian Association. Irene has reported that all schools have been shut until 22nd March so they have had to suspend all the clubs and shut the canteen. This is because many Romanians work in Italy and a lot have returned home. Please remember Irene and the rest of the team at this time.


