Update on Working with Refugees in Shepway

The Thursday afternoon group run in Millfield to give support to teenage refugees continues to go really well. Please pray for all the SKCC volunteers and the refugees themselves.



Before last Christmas, SKCC and Hythe Salvation Army joined together to arrange and fund a bowling trip for around 20 refugees supported by KRAN. The cost of the bowling trip was £10 per person which included the cost of bowling, food, drink and minibus transportation. This figure came about due to a significant discount rate negotiated with the bowling alley.

The following is a report from Callum the Hythe Salvation Army Captain.

"We were a bit nervous on how it would go, as it all felt such a step into the unknown. But 26 of us went on the trip together, and it was a great opportunity for all of us to get to know each other - the individuals being supported by KRAN, the KRAN volunteers, and those who came along from SKCC and the SA. We had great fun, there were lots of conversations and we shared a meal together at the end. I think another benefit was that it seemed to give Wendy and the KRAN staff a bit of breathing space in their hectic schedule! "

A similar trip is being planned for Tuesday 22nd March and the Hythe church leaders want to show their support for this by asking members of their congregations to sponsor places on the trip.

It is also hoped to arrange some different things to happen later in the year.

The churches in Hythe (including SKCC) have joined together to run a prayer group - Hythe Churches Refugee Response (HCRR). This meets every Monday between 8-8.30 p.m. at Hythe United Reformed Church.
