## THE CORNERSTONE CENTRE

The buildings sub-committee met on Thursday evening and discussed options for heating (in particular for the community hall and office area). In the immediate future, electric radiators from another part of the building will be transferred to the office area to enable the office team to relocate from Church House. This allows the committee to continue their research into the pros and cons of either an infra red or gas system, rather than make a hasty decision. Meantime, an application will be made to the council regarding the potential installation of a gas central heating system (The Cornerstone Centre is a listed building so any work affecting the fabric of the building requires consent).

The committee are also investigating installation of a **bike rack** (this too will require planning permission and included with the application above).

### **CAN YOU HELP??**

The committee have identified the following areas (in the first instance) which need volunteers...

Portable Appliance Testing - providing administrative support during the testing process.

Painting/removing carpet tiles - taking up the old carpet tiles and freshening up the walls with a coat of paint.

Clearance - there are several areas of The Cornerstone Centre that need to be cleared/sorted and subsequently items removed from the building and taken to the recycling centre/other.
