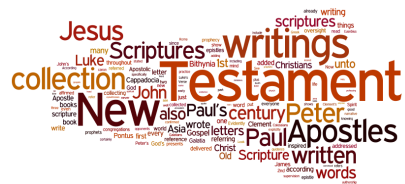


Journeys offers the opportunity to explore the Christian faith, through real people, amazing stories and changed lives.
