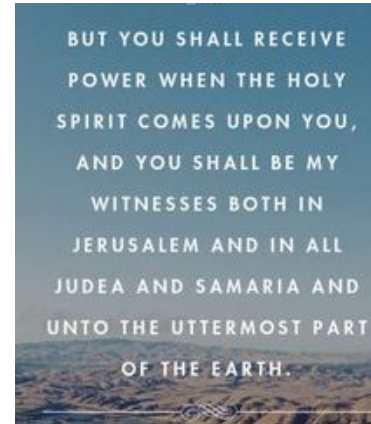

Thursday 19th, Journeys Course at The Gate

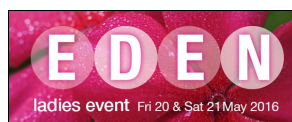
Week 3 - Does this faith thing work in real life?

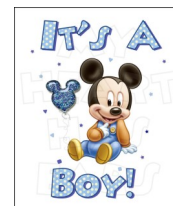
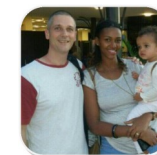

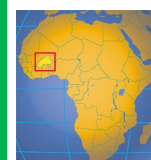
John Sendall-King recovering from his operation plus any others who are struggling with their health at this time.
