Hythe Community Sponsorship — Resettling a Syrian Family

Hythe is preparing to welcome a refugee family under the UK Government's sponsorship scheme.



A steering committee to manage the initiative is already in place, chaired by Sat Callum McKenna of Hythe Salvation Army. As the sponsoring organisation needs to be a registered charity the Salvation Army will take on this role.

Kent County Council has given its support and a suitable property has been identified with the aim of welcoming the family in the first half of 2019. Before then a lot of different working groups need to be set up from fundraisers to flat-pack furniture experts, DIY enthusiasts to electricians and plumbers and then when the family arrives; teachers, talkers and just generally nice people... all are needed and more!
