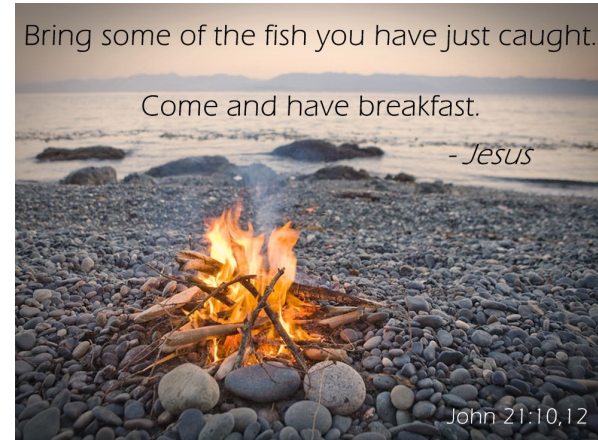

If you would like prayer, please speak to this morning's host or one of the leadership team. Alternatively, you can put a request in the 'prayer box' on the stage.

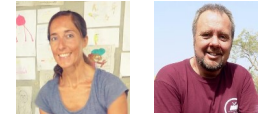
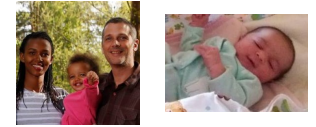
