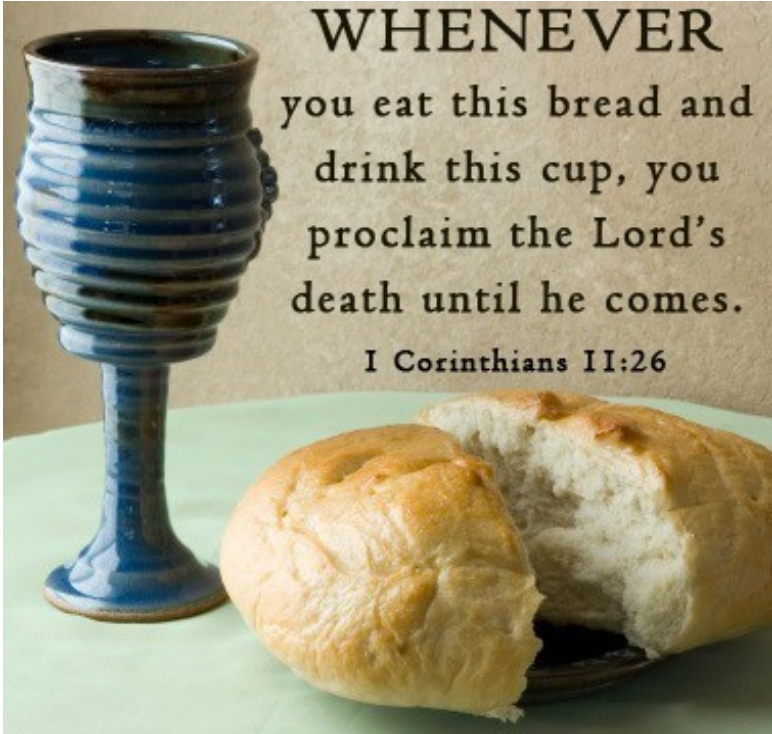

Phil Haines has heard Patrick speak and recommends him.



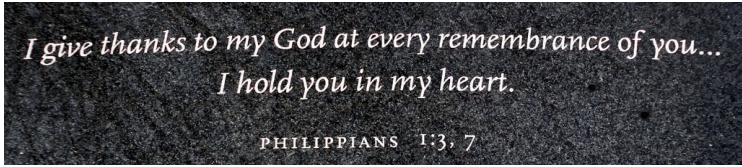
Our March Bridge Service takes place next Sunday when we will be looking at the life of Mary Magdalene.
