





This year will be the 20th year an SKCC team has gone to Romania in the autumn The date is yet to be fixed but will take place in October/ November.

THE CORNERSTONE CENTRE

Following on from the Family Forum this week, we will put a regular slot in the news sheet to keep you updated with news/developments at The Cornerstone Centre.

The journey so far... South Kent Community Church became the owners of the former URC, now known as The Cornerstone Centre, on 19th December 2017 and held its first Sunday morning meeting on Sunday 14th January 2018. We are enjoying our new home.

Since then we successfully obtained planning permission to replace the stolen lead from the front office space and replace the roof with an alternative material. All works on this are now complete.

A fire alarm system has been installed throughout the building, and fixings to the office are in process. The office hope to transfer from their existing offices in August. Electrical testing is also being carried out in line with insurance requirements.

The buildings sub-committee are due to meet on 4th June to discuss and prioritise the next course of action which will include decisions for a new central heating system. Please do pray for them.

Now that we have our own building, we are keen to move away from the polystyrene cups (when we met in school halls we didn't always have the facility to wash up!). Please look out for cups/beakers in the next few weeks.
