

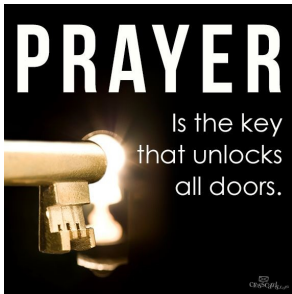
Contact Book 2018

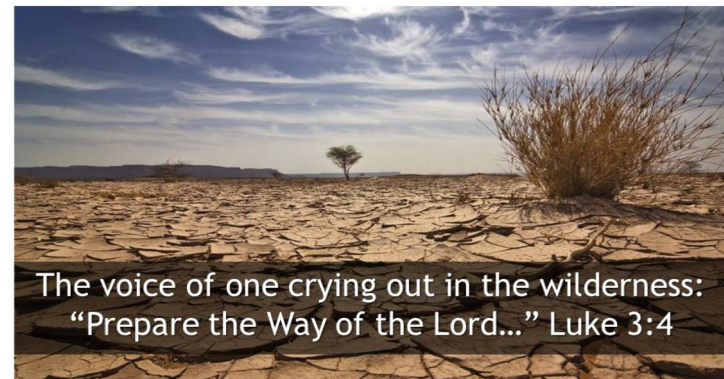
