Thank you to those who prayed for Ciprian and Stella. Sadly, they were unable to find accommodation in this area and have relocated to Liverpool instead.

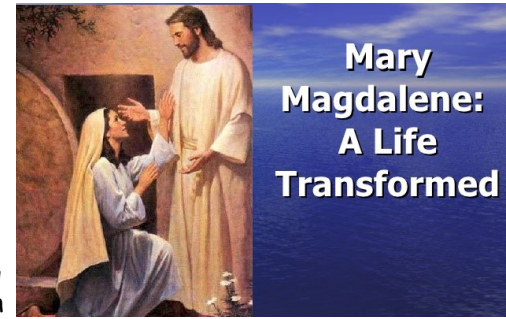
