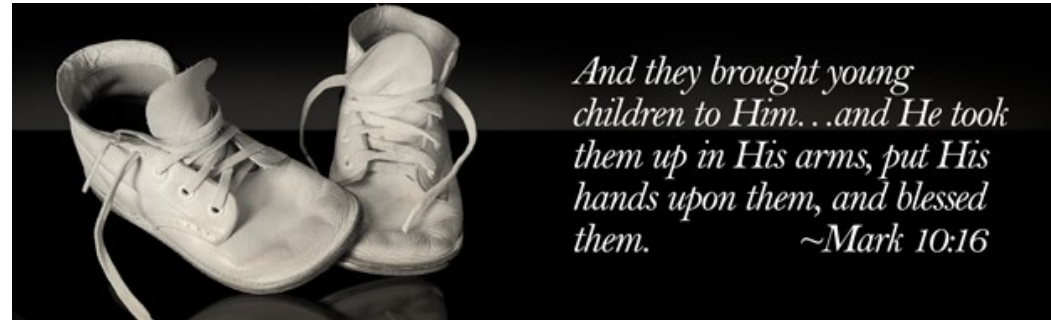

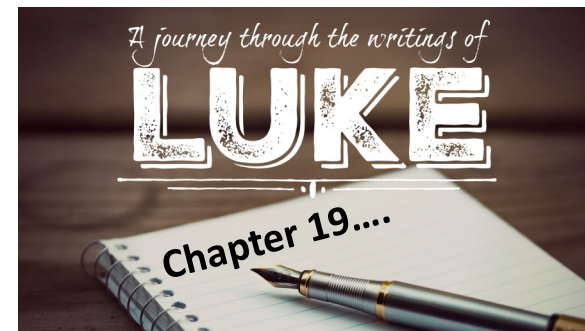

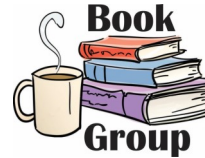


### Christian Medical Fellowship
