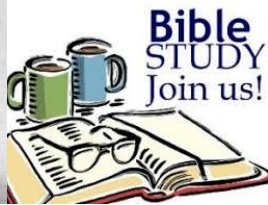
Youth meet in the community hall at the front of the building.

Build Home Moldova 2019

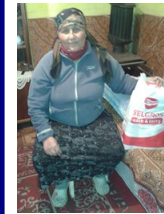
