At approximately 11.15 a.m. the following groups are available for children:




for children aged 0-3

If you are a visitor, please feel free to take a welcome leaflet. Refreshments are served after the meeting. Do join us.




Connect Groups meet mid-week in homes in Hythe, Folkestone and Hawkinge.
