Message from Heather in Kedesh, Mozambique...

"Thank you to everyone who has been praying and sending messages. We are all well at Kedesh Santuario and are doing clean up, repairs and adjusting to a new way of life without electricity and running water. I'm glad the phone lines are now starting to work. As you've now probably heard the cyclone did a lot of damage and sadly many people have died from being hit by trees, falling walls or drowning in the flooding. Others have completely lost their houses or their roof. Please keep praying for the rescue helicopters to find the people who need help and for everyone as they rebuild their houses and try to make ends meet. Many people have asked me what we need. Right now the bank system isn't completely back up but we will need financial help to rebuild houses of our widows and people in the community. We could also really do with more hands to help do the building if people would like to rough it and come and use their building skills! (not right now though as need to wait for banks and shops to get back properly open etc)."
