Sheila started the Folkestone branch of Operation Sunshine in 1984 and the valuable work continues today. For further information go to www.operationsunshine.co.uk



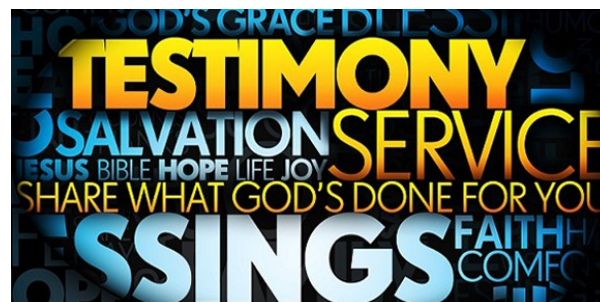
