THE CORNERSTONE CENTRE



As you will have read in last week's news sheet a significant project to restore the clock faces is about to begin, costing approx. £60,000. The first stage is for scaffolding to be erected which will begin on 21st April, followed by repair work starting mid-May and lasting approx. 12 weeks. During this period, a small number of car park spaces will be affected, so we kindly ask that these are prioritised for those with limited mobility.
