PENTECOSTAL FIRE, ENDURING FAITH –

The beginnings and continuings of the early church

1. Acts – The coming of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit is for everyone and the disciples are empowered to be witnesses.
2. Acts – The big gear change. Two big events demonstrate that the Spirit really is for EVERYONE.
3. Acts – Paul takes centre stage. After his dramatic conversion, Paul is off preaching and church-planting, continually facing dangers.
4. Acts – All roads lead to Rome. The story ends in Rome but not in the way Paul intends. But does the story ever properly end?
5. Heroes & Heresies. After Acts, new leaders emerge, new churches develop but opposition comes from outside and within the faith.
6. Canon & Creeds. Big decisions are made on beliefs and scripture; Christianity is given official Roman approval but is this a good place to be for the gospel?
