This **Tuesday, 21st July**, come and spend time in God's Word as we learn, discuss and encourage one another. All welcome. There are two opportunities:

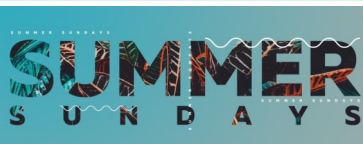
