*"To be in your presence, not rushing away, where your love surrounds me, here I will stay.*

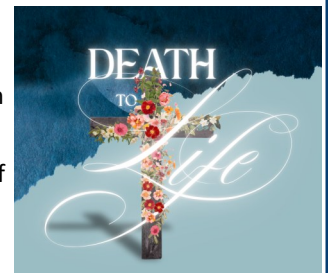
*This is my desire O God"*
