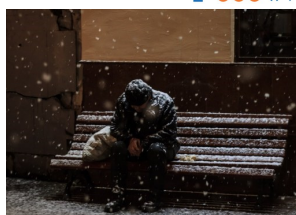

Reimbursement for food costs is available via the church office, as is loan of some kitchen equipment if needed.
