Raising a Generation Children's Worker Training

Venue: Harbour Church, Canterbury Road, Folkestone.

Amor Europe undertakes training in children's work (those aged under 18) for church leaders, children's workers and those wanting to become children's workers. Our area of specialism is operating in countries where the culture is hostile to the church.

There are 6 training sessions which have been newly written, or completely reworked over the last 12 months. The training has been written specifically to areas of training we have observed there is need among youth workers to enjoy greater skills/confidence, leading to more effective work. Session titles include: What is the Good News, Effective evangelism, Creation care, Sexuality and the child, Learn, live, lead and Transforming justice.

Amor has yet to have an opportunity of delivering this training overseas so would really appreciate live 'testing' them on people in the UK first. Feedback will be welcome on improvement, suggestions etc. So if you are highly experienced or if you've little or no experience you will probably enjoy the times for different reasons.

There is no cost for the sessions which it is hoped will be highly beneficial for you and for Amor Europe!
