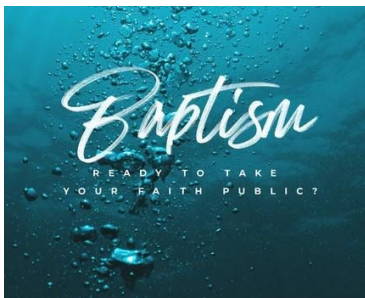
Next Sunday
