1st December 2023 to 31st March 2024.

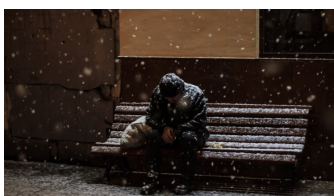
Winter Shelter will be using local B&B's to provide overnight shelter and Alison Short, with support from Matthew Sawyer, will be co-ordinating Saturday night food provision/serving at the B&B's on behalf of SKCC.

The key roles we are looking to fill are help to **prepare/cook** a savoury & sweet course for up to 14 guests (this can be shared), **serving/befriending** at the B & B (approx. 5 - 7 p.m.) and **drivers** to collect meals and deliver to the B & B as may be needed. Do consider how you can help and sign up as you are able on the board in the main hall.

If you are going to be on site at the B & B you will also need to complete an application form and have a DBS check. Please take a form from the notice board or access from the link below and return to the church office by 8th November.
