The key roles we are looking to fill are help to prepare/cook a savoury & sweet course for up to 14 guests (this can be shared), serving/befriending at the B & B (approx. 5 - 7 p.m.) and drivers to collect meals and deliver to the B & B as may be needed. Do consider how you can help and sign up as you are able on the board in the main hall.
