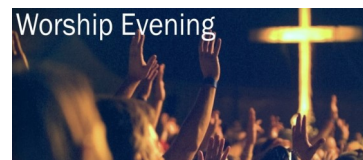

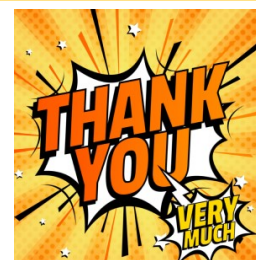
**Drop In** is in desperate need of the following:
